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Introduction

Berkshire Record Office (BRO) was established in 1948 to locate and preserve records relating to the county of Berkshire and its people, and to make them available for research to anyone who is interested in the county's past.

This is a guide to sources at BRO for schools in the Vale of White Horse area which was transferred to Oxfordshire in 1974.
